About

Welcome to our Overseas Immunisation Documentation Catch Up Service. Our experienced immunisation nurse is here to help you register overseas vaccines and create a comprehensive catchup plan.



- Step 1- Documentation collection:
 You will be required to bring in original hard copies of all previous vaccination records from all countries where immunisation has been performed. Ensure any non-English documents are translated by an official service prior to commencing this service.
 You may wish to utilise TIS https://translating.homeaffairs.gov.au/en.
- Step 2- Complete Immunisation
 Documentation Catch Up Service
 Registration Form
- Step 3- Registration and Planning:
 Our nurse will register your vaccines and create a tailored catch-up plan.





Requirements and costs:

Patient Requirements:

-Original copies of all previous vaccination documentation from all countries where immunisation has been performed.

-Official translations for any non-English documents.

-Completion of application form.

Cost:

The service is offered at a flat rate of \$180.
